On April 3 in Paris, the premier modern and contemporary art fair ***Art Paris*** will once again descend upon the legendary ***Grand Palais***, on view through April 6. Throughout newly renovated Nave and balcony realms, visitors from around the world will have the opportunity to discover showcases from 170 dynamic exhibitors hailing from 25 countries.

French artist **Barbara Navi** studied architecture and philosophy at the legendary **Sorbonne**, leading to a meticulous creative process which includes photography, iconographic research, collage, and layouts. Her poetic, haunting pieces speak to the indefiniteness of life as we know it with blurred imagery and surreal, contradictory moments.
